RETHINK YOUR DRINK

Allyne and Katie participated in the Rethink Your Drink Infused Water Contest at the Ukiah Farmers' Market in July. Did you know?... Sugary beverages are the largest single source of calories in the American diet. Greater sugary beverage consumption is associated with weight gain, obesity and diabetes. The average person in the U.S. drank 45 gallons of sugary beverages in 2009. In Mendocino County 55.7% of adults and adolescents and 42.7% of 5th, 7th and 9th graders are overweight or obese.

Increased access to more healthful beverages is important for reducing sugary beverage consumption and decreasing the prevalence of chronic diseases in Mendocino County. Therefore, Mendocino County Public Health, Prevention and Planning hosted the Infused Water Contest to promote the healthiest and most beneficial beverage available - WATER.

Our Identifying Project, the 57th Soroptimist Invitational Dolphins Swim Meet, is a Pacific Swimming Short Course C/B/A+ Meet. It is a large meet hosting over 20 teams from around the Redwood Empire and the North Bay Area.

The meet was a great success this year. They had almost double the participants with 359 swimmers, from elementary school age up to high school. It is always exciting to present the awards to the swimmers, but due to the increased number of participants it was impossible to keep up, so some of the awards will be presented by the coaches when the teams return home. Next year we're going to need more volunteers to help.

To add to the excitement 10 year old Winn Aung from the Redding Swim Team broke 2 national age group records, 50 yard freestyle at 24.42 and 100 yard freestyle at 53.12. We presented him with a special award for breaking the records.

EMPOWERMENT: Women and girls are free to act in their own best interest.


